Bromsgrove School has just achieved superb IGCSE and GCSE results following on from its highest ever A Level and International Baccalaureate scores.

171 pupils sat over 1, 700 public examinations. In core subjects (English, Maths and Science) all pupils sat the more challenging IGCSE. 27% of all GCSE and IGCSE grades were A\*, 56% were A\* and A, while 82% were A\* to B. A fifth of the year group scored six or more A\*, with nine local pupils scoring ten or more A\* each.
