Main Responsibilities

- 1. Run triage clinic sessions and book in students. Assess, diagnose injuries and write follow up records.
- 2. Provide pitch side first aid every Saturday of term time including travelling away with 1st team on a Saturday and occasionally mid-week.
- 3. Monitor personal medical bag and supplies and advise Line Manager when supplies need to be replaced.
- 4. Write rehabilitation programmes and assist students through rehabilitation and return to active sports play.
- 5. Communicate appropriately and professionally with sports staff, Houseparents and parents ensuring they are kept up to date on a student's injury and advise if they also need hospital support for their recovery.
- 6. Contribute to an effective athletic development structure and engage actively in continuous personal development and the progression of Bromsgrove Sport.
- 7. Educate students in their understanding of sports principles whilst providing opportunities to develop a rounded athletic skillset and sports specific physical qualities.

- 8. Work with the Heads of Department, Directors of Sports and Sports Coaches to build a strong culture of development within Bromsgrove School and continue to improve upon the framework of best practice.
- 9. Assist sports coaches and teaching staff in sport principles and practices.
- 10. Work collaboratively with colleagues and communicate diligently with them, parents and the School as needed in respect of students' training and development.
